

Subject: Kart2Kart

Kart2Kart, patterned after Stephan Johanssen's indoor Kart track in Indianapolis, is expected to open soon in Sterling Heights.

Located on Van Dyke just south of 19 Mile road, it is a brand new building designed by the same architect that did the design for Johanssen. There is also a conference center attached for groups up to 135 for banquets and a standing reception for 250.

There are two indoor courses - a large twisty road course and a smaller near oval. They will be using European designed and manufactured JB Kart's and anticipate speeds up to 30 MPH.

They will be offering several different race formats: A Grand Prix that includes practice, qualifying, heat race and main event and an Indy Endurance where a team is assigned to a Kart and there is a driver change every 8 minutes. They're also planning on putting together a league. All this comes at a cost, and if you think Whirlyball is expensive sit down before reading further.....

Open practice (8 minutes of wheel to wheel racing) is \$17. Some discounts are available if you buy in quantity, ie: purchase ten practice sessions in advance and get the 11th and 12th free, for example. The large track goes for \$800/hr Mon - Wed and \$950/hr Thu - Sun and can handle about 65 people an hour and 8 to 12 Karts. The small track goes for \$400/hr Mon - Wed and \$600/hr Thu - Sun and about 30 people an hour with 4 to 6 Karts. They supply helmets and Karting suits.


