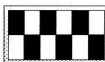

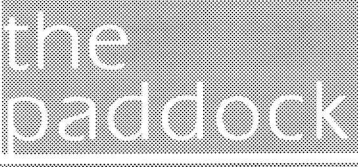

The weekend of August 4 was our final PCA Club race of the year at Gingerman Raceway. The Southeast Michigan Region put on an awesome event that was very well organized and a lot of fun. The only update that we

made to the 914 was the addition of a rear wing. Dan found that he had too much over steer at Putnam Park so he added the rear wing to help alleviate this problem. During the Friday test and tune he found that he didn't have an over steer problem anymore but now he had an under steer problem which is common at Gingerman. Despite a new problem to overcome he was very happy with his lap times which were about 2 - 3 seconds faster than last year. He started to make adjustments to tire pressures, front sway bar and to the wing itself. And each time he went out the car felt better but still not quite right. For Sunday he put on his new tires which improved the car's handling and he qualified forth in his class! The race itself was very exciting to watch. Dan was able to jump to third at the drop of the green flag. He held on to third despite Claudio Keampf 's efforts to pass him. Dan was still struggling in the corners but he had power on the straights. About mid race Leo Wanstreet of SEM broke an oil line and unfortunately laid down oil on the front straight and turn one. The race was black flagged and all the racers had to come into the pits. The SEM region volunteers sprang into action providing water and wet towels to the racers as they waited for the track to be cleared. Once the race resumed we had a 4 lap sprint to the finish. Once again Dan held off Claudio to bring home Third Place!! The corner workers must have had some fun watching Dan and Claudio race that day because they gave Dan the Worker's Choice Award! There is nothing like finishing the race season on such a high note and again I would like to thank all those who helped us get here: Jim Dunham, Eric Hahne, Dave Hauser, Scott Hoag, Bob Sandau, Vaughan Scott, and Leo Wanstreet.

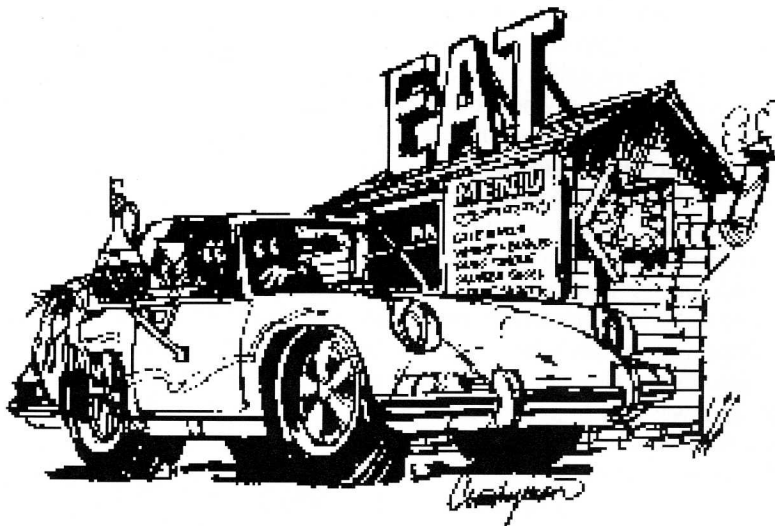
our website. Again please let me know as soon as possible if you plan to attend and what dish you'll bring along to share.

F.Y.I.

WATERFORD HILLS ROAD RACING leases their road course to car clubs under the grace of an operating permit from Independence Township. The weekday operating parameters of this permit allow for vehicles that meet the following description to be allowed on the track for events between the hours of 10:00am – 5:00 (PM).

... "Production exhaust systems, totally stock type cars equipped with mufflers Mufflers must silence to a maximum level of 75 dBA measured at the property line". . .

The hours of operation for club events that include race cars (defined as cars prepared in such a way as to be eligible to participate in WHRRI race and/or vintage events: and/or vehicles that have a history of participation in WHRRI, SCCA, CASC or other racing events) are from 12:00 Noon – 4:00 PM. Certain vehicles prepared to "Showroom Stock" specifications may be permitted to participate in the 10-5 category event.

In all cases cars must be silenced to the 75-dBA limit.

- Cars that exceed the limit by 1-2 dB's will be notified and requested to meet the standard. If they continue to exceed the standard they will be excused from further participation in (the) event.
- Cars that exceed the limit by 3 dB will be excluded from further participation in the event.

WATERFORD HILLS MEASURES DBA AT WEEKDAY EVENTS FOR COMPLIANCE TO THE ORDINANCE STANDARD ONLY.

RACE PREPARED VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED AT WEEKDAY EVENTS OTHER THAN OPEN PRACTICE SESSIONS AND SCHEDULED PRIVATE TEST DAYS.

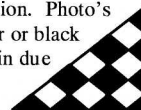
Well hope to see you at an upcoming event. There are plenty to choose from.

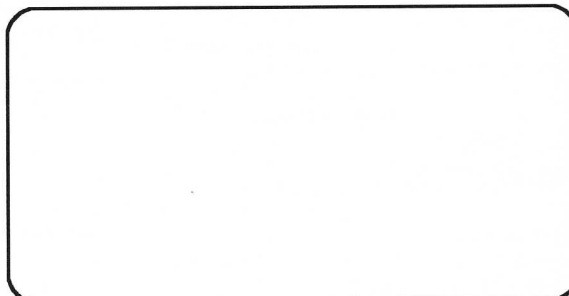
