
our website. Again please let me know as soon as possible if you plan to attend and what dish you'll bring along to share.

### F.Y.I.

WATERFORD HILLS ROAD RACING leases their road course to car clubs under the grace of an operating permit from Independence Township. The weekday operating parameters of this permit allow for vehicles that meet the following description to be allowed on the track for events between the hours of 10:00am – 5:00 (PM).

... "Production exhaust systems, totally stock type cars equipped with mufflers Mufflers must silence to a maximum level of 75 dBA measured at the property line"...

The hours of operation for club events that include race cars (defined as cars prepared in such a way as to be eligible to participate in WHRRI race and/or vintage events: and/or vehicles that have a history of participation in WHRRI, SCCA, CASC or other racing events) are from 12:00 Noon - 4:00 PM. Certain vehicles prepared to "Showroom Stock" specifications may be permitted to participate in the 10-5 category event.

### In all cases cars must be silenced to the 75-dBA limit.

- Cars that exceed the limit by 1-2 dB's will be notified and requested to meet the standard. If they continue to exceed the standard they will be excused from further participation in (the) event.
- Cars that exceed the limit by 3 dB will be excluded from further participation in the event.

WATERFORD HILLS MEASURES DBA AT WEEKDAY EVENTS FOR COMPLIANCE TO THE ORDINANCE STANDARD ONLY.

RACE PREPARED VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED AT WEEKDAY EVENTS OTHER THAN OPEN PRACTICE SESSIONS AND SCHEDULED PRIVATE TEST DAYS.
