Inspections:

- Detailed Information: <http://rsp.pca.org/TechInspections.html>
- First event: Required, on-hoist, under car, tech inspection by an ASE licensed tech besides yourself unless you have been approved by Tim Pott.
- A full, on-hoist tech inspection is required every three track events, every six days of track usage or every 2,000 miles of driving, whichever is least.

- If there is any incident, such as an off: A full, on-hoist inspection before our next event is required.
- In-between events: Normal "at track" tech only is required. Approved (by Tim Pott) Red & Blue participants can tech their own cars for the "at track" portion of the inspection.
- Water cooled, "Mezger" engines are defined by any six cylinder, dry sump engine found in most GT2, GT3 and Turbo charged Porsche 996 and 997 models.

- Battery securely held down with metal mounts
- Battery Positive post covered
- Engine and transmission mounts secure
- Fan belts (tension and condition)
- Water line pinned or welded (Mezger engine)

 - Head & neck restraint, if harnesses are used
- Tire pressure (typically, min low-30s PSI for street tires)
- Lug nuts torqued to 90 ft-lb or manufacturer specifications
(Non-security key and steel lug nuts recommended)
(Center lock wheels - you must supply torque wrench)
- Wheel covers / center cap removed
- Gas cap tight
- Oil cap tight
- Brake fluid checked
- Brake lights (all 3, if applicable)
- Helmet SA2010 or SA2015
- Appropriate clothing and shoes
